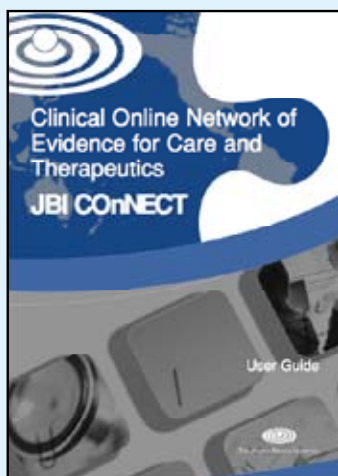




NHS Quality Improvement Scotland (NHS QIS) has secured membership of the Joanna Briggs Institute (JBI) and all NHSScotland employees have access to the evidence-based tools and resources on the JBI clinical online network of evidence for care and therapeutics (CONNECT) website.

NHS QIS aims to support the translation of evidence into practice and the delivery of best practice by providing access to the healthcare information, procedure manuals, international evidence summaries, recommended practices, audit tools and quality improvement resources available through the JBI CONNECT website.

What is JBI CONNECT?



JBI CONNECT is a web-based facility that is designed to meet the needs of service providers, healthcare professionals and patients and carers, and enhance care by connecting the best available international evidence to the point-of-care.

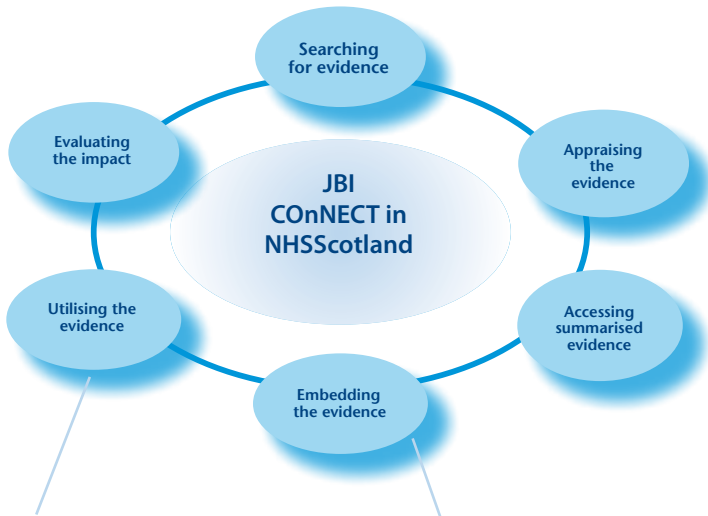
